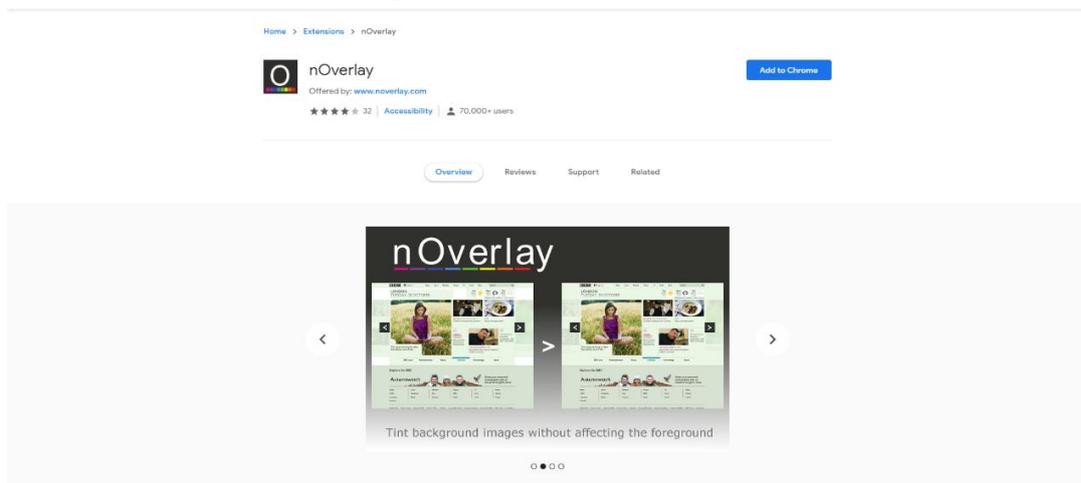


NOVERLAY EXTENSION ON GOOGLE CHROME

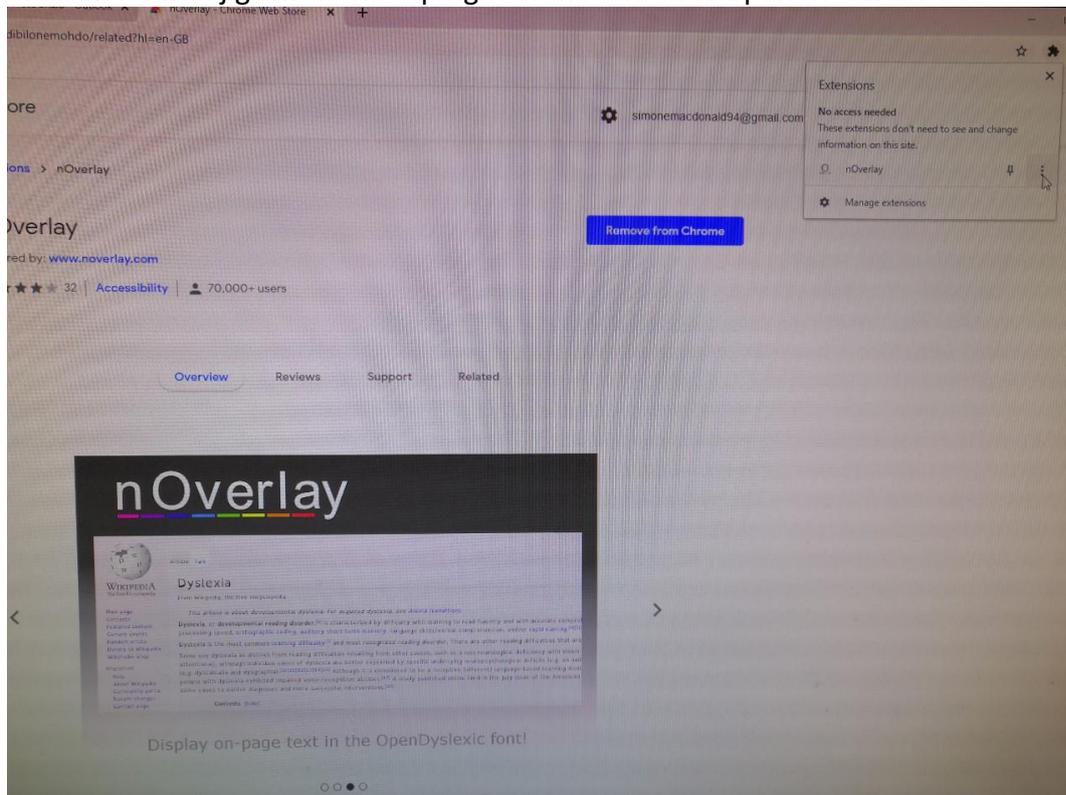
Here's a handy Google Chrome extension online called Overlay which acts in the same way as an overlay on paper would. This is beneficial for some of our dyslexic pupils. Here's how to install it:

- 1: Open up Google Chrome
- 2: Type in nOverlay in the search bar
- 3: Open the first link
- 4: Click the "Add to Chrome" Button

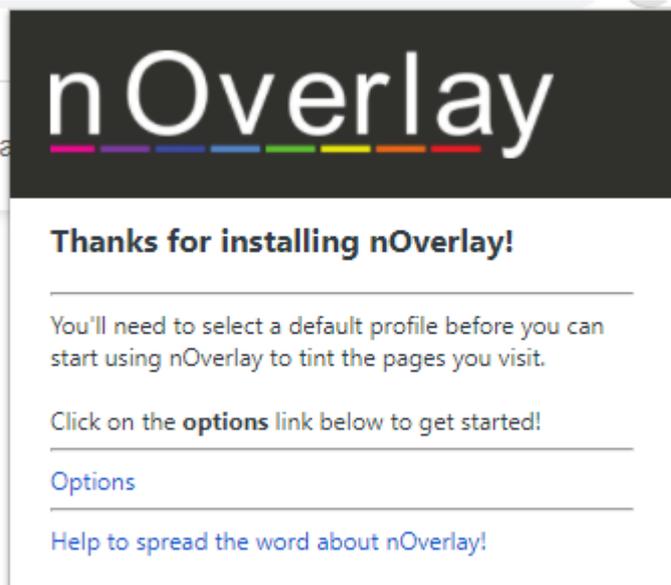


5: A pop-up will appear saying "are you sure?" confirm.

6: Click the wee jigsaw at the top right of the screen to open the extension



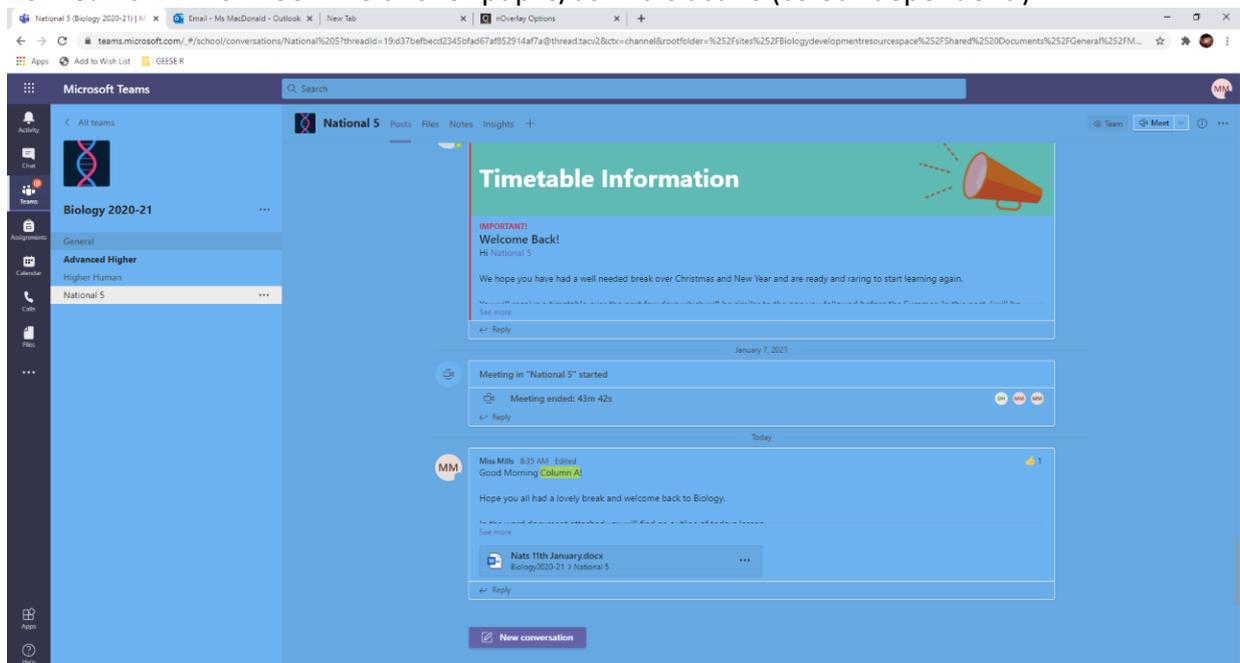
7: Click nOverlay and then select options



8: On the options menu there's the standard overlay colours

9: You can either preview to the colour to make it slightly darker/lighter and then save the new colour, or simply make default which will then apply that colour to all of your tabs. (you will need to refresh each website to load it on. This will remain active until you close nOverlay 😊)

10: Teams will now look like this for pupils/us if it is active (colour dependent)
